**Veterinary camp** held at Nagalamadaka on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2011. The main objective of the camp is there are many disease conditions for which sheep and goats may be vaccinated. All flocks and herds should be vaccinated for clostridial diseases, specifically enterotoxemia (type C and D) (Lambs/kids are usually found dead from enterotoxemia) and tetanus.

To start with, veterinary camp for de-worming goats and sheep's was very **SUCCESSFUL**. Firstly would like to thank each and every doctor and team who took time out on a Sunday for this noble cause and without them it would have not been possible to make the veterinary camp a success.
