About the Temple

Shri Subramanya Swamy heritage temple in Nagalamadike village situated on the banks of North Pinakini river is favourite of many devotees. The temple is rich in both legend and history. In this temple Lord Sri Subramanya assumes the form of a "Brahmachari" (bachelor) as he took this form to slay the demon Tarakasura and was named Tarakajeet. The devotees congregate from far and wide during Ceremonial Carriage (Rathothsava) on the 6th day of Pushya month every year to pay obeisance to the Lord and receive his blessings.

(Temple is 15 kms away from Pavagada of Tumkur district in Karnataka and is well connected by road and easily reachable)
